New York's 2024 Delegates to the Democratic National Convention Endorse Vice President Kamala Harris for President of the United States

NEW YORK – Today, New York's delegation to the 2024 Democratic National Convention voted to endorse Vice President Kamala Harris for the Democratic nomination for President.
